<b>What is the name of the competition?</b>	Win your travel money back
<b>Products</b>	Cash Passport Platinum Mastercard New Zealand
<b>Who is entitled to enter the competition (the “Entry Requirements”)?</b>	<p>During the Competition Period, entrants must be either new or existing customers to Cash Passport Platinum Mastercard, who load a minimum of \$500 in NZD equivalent in a single transaction in foreign currency onto their card.</p> <p>Cardholders will be automatically entered into the draw by completing the above, subject to these Conditions of Entry. <b>Who is not allowed to enter the competition (the “Ineligible Entrants”)?</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Entrants aged under 18 years at the start date of the Competition Period;</li><li>• Employees and contractors of Mastercard and immediate family members of employees and contractors; and</li><li>• Employees and contractors of Sussex Australasia Pty Ltd and immediate family members of employees and contractors</li></ul>
<b>What is the applicable region?</b>	New Zealand wide
<b>How does someone enter the competition (the “Entry Method”)?</b>	During the Competition Period, the Entrant must load a minimum of \$500 NZD equivalent in one transaction in foreign currency, onto their new or existing Cash Passport Platinum Mastercard
<b>When will the competition run (the “Competition Period”)?</b>	The competition starts on 10 July 2024 at 00.01 am Sydney time and close on 11 August 2024 at 11.59 am/pm Sydney time.
<b>How will the winner and runners up be chosen?</b>	<p>Chance to win draw (game of chance)</p> <p>5 Winners will be picked at random through computerised random draw.</p> <p>Should winners choose to not accept the Prize, a secondary draw will be completed to identify other winners.</p>

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### ***Conditions of Entry***

1. These Conditions of Entry must be read together with the Schedule. By entering, entrants accept these conditions.
2. Entry is open to residents of the Applicable State/s who comply with the Entry Requirements (if any). Entries submitted by Ineligible Entrants are not accepted.
3. The competition will be run during the Competition Period.
4. The Prize is not transferable or exchangeable and cannot be redeemed for cash. If a winner does not take a part of the Prize at the time set by the Promoter, the winner will forfeit that part. Promoter accepts no responsibility for changes in Prize value. If a Prize is unavailable, Promoter will substitute it for one of equal or greater value.
